ELIGIBILITY *

Subject to the rules on disqualification, a person is qualified if they are a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any member state of the European Union and on the relevant day, has attained the age of 18 years and:

- is a local government elector for the Parish; or
- during the previous 12 months has occupied land or other premises in the Parish as an owner or tenant; or
- during the previous 12 months their principal or only place of work has been in the Parish; or
- during the previous 12 months has resided in the Parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it.
