Assisted Rubbish Collection

Sevenoaks District Council may be able to help if you're unable to carry your rubbish and recycling sacks to the boundary of your property for collection.

If no-one else can help, assisted collections are available for residents who are frail, elderly or those with disabilities who cannot lift or carry their rubbish and recycling sacks.

In such cases, sacks need to be left in an agreed location close to the house by 7am on the collection day. Council staff cannot enter homes to remove rubbish and recycling.

The District Council regret that this service is not available for their garden waste collection service.

Anti-Social Motorbike Activity

Residents are reminded that the riding of motorbikes/mini motorbikes and similar vehicles is <u>NOT</u> permitted on any of the Council's open spaces, which include Woodland Avenue, Chantry Avenue and Longfield Hill playgrounds, Hartley Wood, Gorse Wood, Rectory Meadow, Manor Field, Billings Hill Shaw and Northfield.

The riding of the above vehicles in any of these areas is classed as anti-social behaviour.

If you see anyone riding these vehicles illegally you can report it to the police by telephone on 101 or online;



Changes to waste and recycling sacks

In March 2024, Sevenoaks District Council announced that it would no longer be delivering free black sacks to residents. The Parish Office did have a small supply of black sacks but this has run out and we are no longer able to obtain any more to sell to residents.

Residents can purchase any black or grey sacks from supermarkets or hardware shops for their refuse and these will be collected in the usual way.

In the Autumn, residents will receive a new "Sack for life" which will replace the clear plastic sacks currently provided by the District Council.
